FAQ: FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

LUCAS OIL DRAG RACING SERIES DOUBLE HEADER

Q: Can I park the weekend prior?

A: WWTR hosts Summit ET Series races April 26–27. Racers arriving before 10:00 AM Saturday AND competing in those events, may stay for the LODRS Doubleheader but could be asked to move if in a reserved spot. Official LODRS parking begins Monday, April 28 at 10:00 AM. Contact WWTR.

Q: When Does Stacking Begin?

A: Stacking begins at 8:00 AM on Monday. Racers will enter through the Collinsville Road entrance. Nightly stacking will begin at 8:00 PM each evening. All racers will stack and enter through 1905 Collinsville Rd

Q: Can I Park Anywhere in the Facility?

A: Parking attendants will assist racers. Reserved spots are for Sponsors and Comp classes. NASCAR infield access is limited and will be used last. No LODRS racers allowed in the infield after 7:00 PM Saturday.

Q: How Do I Enter the Race?

A: Pre-entries can be purchased at www.nhradiv5.com, the WWTR website, or through bit.ly/3EIGfAa.

Q: Where Do I Fill Out the Online Tech Card?

A: After completing registration, you'll receive the link in your confirmation email.

Q: Is This a Division 5 or Division 3 Event?

A: This is a Division 5 event. West Central racers will earn home division points, while Division 3 racers will receive out-of-division points.

Q: Do I Need to Go to the Racer Registration trailer?

A: Yes, all racers must check in at registration to receive their run card and verify their tech card submission. No one will be permitted to make a run down the track without their run card. The trailer will be located near the scales.

Q: Will Paper Time Slips be Provided?

A: No, WWTR uses a mobile app for time slips. Please be sure to download the app to view your runs. Download WWT Slips.

Q: When & Where Will RFC Hold Chapel Service?

A: Saturday morning at 7am in Suites 306 & 308

Q: What is the Laris Super Shootout?

A: During qualifying session #2, Super Comp (SC), Super Gas (SG), and Super Street (SST) racers can enter the Laris Motorsports Super Shootout. The 8 racers closest to their class index without going under will qualify for eliminations. The entry fee is \$20, cash only, and will be collected in the staging lanes by RFC. Payouts for Race 1 include \$400 for the winner, \$200 for the runner-up, \$100 for the semi-finalists, and \$50 for the quarterfinalists. For Race 2, the 8 qualifiers will split the purse evenly.

Q: Where will daily schedules and updates be announced?

A: Updates will be shared on Discord, Facebook, and the Division 5 website.

Q: Will The Race be Livestreamed?

A: Yes, NHRA.TV and YouTube.

Q: If I Only Show Up for the Second Race, Will I Get (2) Time Trials or Qualifying Attempts?

A: Competitors in Comp, Top Dragster, and Top Sportsman are guaranteed two qualifying runs. All other classes will receive one. If time permits, new arrivals may get a time trial on Thursday evening; however, it will not count toward qualifying.

Q: Where Do I Get Payouts?
